#### **Domestic Abuse – An Example Close to Home**

- Preliminary Examination 3B District Court (St. Joseph County, MI)
  - Conducted via Zoom
  - "Assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder"
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> offense & violation of no contact order
- Alleged perpetrator was in same apartment as alleged victim
- Called alleged victim from jail more charges are pending










Suicide Ideation or Plan
